



Conditions of participation

The European Future Challenge is aimed at students' contributions / essays on topics relating to EU law, honouring the best essays on a national and international level.

The competition will take place in the following countries: Austria, Bulgaria, Czech Republic, Hungary, Romania and Slovak Republic.

The essay competition will examine the subject of the "Green Innovation in European Law". In 2022, the specific topic will be: The European Green Deal and other legal innovations related to the issue of climate change in Europe.

Papers must be submitted electronically as a PDF, to be sent to golegal@cerhahempel.com / vpaa@elsa-austria.org.

Essays must not exceed 15 pages, including footnotes.

The participants should also submit a CV and a motivation letter to the National ELSA Group.

Entries must meet the following the following requirements:

- The essay must be written in English
- Running text: 1.5 spaced; footnotes, bibliography and block quotations: single-spaced
Standard font: Arial, 10.5 pt
- "Normal" margins in Word are to be used throughout.
- Each page of the essay must be numbered consecutively

Participants should be law students in at least their second year of study, or graduates or young professionals with fewer than two years of post-graduation experience. Employees of CERHA HEMPEL are not allowed to participate.

The award will be granted to the best overall essay (i) in each country (National Award) and (ii) out of these the overall winner (International Award).

Entries can be submitted until 30 June 2022.
